Did you know that in Winnebago County, almost 20,000 households are considered to be "Food Insecure", the lack of enough food for a healthy lifestyle. That is almost 12% of the population for the entire county.

The Winnebago County Sheriff's Office, along with seven other Law Enforcement agencies from around the Fox Valley have partnered to start 2017 by initiating **Operation #ArrestingHunger**. In friendly competition with each other, the eight agencies will be collecting four of the most needed food staples highest in demand for the St. Joseph's Food Program during the first four months of 2017. The competition will be starting on January 1, 2017 and continue through April 30, 2017 at each of the following agencies: Winnebago County Sheriff's Office, Neenah Police Department, Village of Fox Crossing Police Department, Menasha Police Department, Outagamie County Sheriff's Office, Appleton Police Department, Fox Valley Metro Police Department and the Grand Chute Police Department.

Each month will focus on a different food staple most needed by the St. Joseph's Food Program located in Menasha that supplies thousands of underprivileged families throughout the Fox Valley with non-perishable food items. Listed below are the items for each month;

February	Jam/Jelly
March	Tuna
April	Pasta/Pasta Sauces
